GCBL SUMMER KICKOFF AND ANNIE OAKLEY TOURNAMENT RULES 10U GAME PLAY

(NFHS rules will apply with the following exceptions)

- 1. Teams will field 9 players (including 3 outfielders.) Failure to field at least 9 players at any time will result in a forfeit. Forfeit time is 10 minutes after the scheduled game time. Pitchers will be given 5 warm up pitches before game, in between innings, and pitching changes.
- 2. 10U pitches from a 46' rubber and use 60' bases. Each pitcher is restricted to 3 innings per game. One pitch is considered one inning. Pitchers may not re-enter as a pitcher once they have been removed.
- 3. Balks will be called and enforced after each pitcher has received a warning.
- 4. A complete game consists of 6 innings. All pool play games will have a 1 hour and 45 minute time limit. No new inning after 1 hour and 45 minutes. All bracket play games will have a 2 hour time limit. No new inning after 2 hours. There is no time limit for championship games.
- 5. Run Rule is 12 runs after 4 complete innings and 10 runs after 5 compete innings. It is not necessary to play the bottom of the inning if the home team is winning.
- 6. Tie breakers for seeding purposes:
 - 1. Win-Loss record
 - 2. Head to head
 - 3. Runs allowed
 - 4. Run differential (max run differential is + or 8 runs)
 - 5. Coin flip
- 7. Infield fly rule will not be enforced.
- 8. Courtesy runners are encouraged to help speed up the game. A courtesy runner may be used for the pitcher or catcher with 2 outs. The runner must be the player who made the last out at the plate.
- 9. The maximum amount of 3 coaches allowed in the dugout.
- 10. Teams must roster bat entire roster with free substitution.
- 11. No altered or shaved bats allowed.
- 12. Batters will be called out for throwing bats. No warning will be issued.
- 13. Players will only play on one team's roster for this tournament.
- 14. The maximum amount of players on a roster is 15.
- 15. A runner who fails to slide to avoid contact may be called out. A player may face ejection if malicious contact was made. This is at the umpire's discretion.

- 16. Coin toss will determine home and away in all pool play games. Home team in bracket play will be determined by the higher seed. If both teams have the same seed a coin flip will determine home and away.
- 17. No amplified speakers allowed at the ballpark. ie. Walk up music/ warm up music.
- 18. In the event of a weather issue, every effort will be made to get all the games played. The tournament director has the right to shorten games and change all scheduling to accommodate. Refund policy is as follows: 75% refund if no games played (covers trophies and diamond dry.)
- 19. No pets allowed on property.
