

GCBL TOURNAMENT RULES

8U GAME PLAY

(NFHS rules will apply with the following exceptions)

1. Teams will field 10 players (including 4 outfielders.) Failure to field at least 9 players at any time will result in a forfeit. Forfeit time is 10 minutes after the scheduled game time.
2. One defensive coach may be used in the outfield for instructional purposes only.
3. A complete game consists of 6 innings. All pool play games will have a 1 hour and 30 minute time limit. No new inning after 1 hour and 30 minutes. All bracket play games will have a 2 hour time limit. No new inning after 2 hours. There is no time limit for championship games.
4. Run Rule is 12 runs after 4 complete innings and 10 runs after 5 complete innings. It is not necessary to play the bottom of the inning if the home team is winning.
5. Base runners may not lead off until the ball crosses the plate. An umpire may call a runner out for leaving a base early.
6. Infield fly rule will not be enforced.
7. The defensive pitcher must be within 6 feet of the rubber while the ball is pitched.
8. A hit ball will remain live until an infielder has control of the ball in the dirt. Once the infielder has control of the ball, time will be called. The baserunner can advance to the base they are going to, but can't advance past that base.
9. Batters will be given 6 pitches or 3 strikes. A batter can't strike out on a foul ball.
10. The maximum amount of 3 coaches allowed in the dugout.
11. An inning will consist of 3 outs or 7 runs. The last inning is open on runs.
12. Courtesy runners are encouraged to help speed up the game. A courtesy runner may be used for the pitcher or catcher with 2 outs. The runner must be the player who made the last out at the plate.
13. Teams must roster bat entire roster with free substitution.
14. No altered or shaved bats allowed.
15. Coaches can pitch anywhere between home plate and the rubber. Any ball that hits the pitcher (coach) will be an immediate dead ball and the pitched again.
16. Batters will be called out for throwing bats. No warning will be issued.
17. Players will only play on one team's roster for this tournament.
18. The maximum amount of players on a roster is 15.
19. A runner who fails to slide to avoid contact may be called out. A player may face ejection if malicious contact was made. This is at the umpire's discretion.
20. Coin toss will determine home and away in all pool play games. Home team in bracket play will be determined by the higher seed. If both teams have the same seed a coin flip will determine home and away.

21. Tie breakers for seeding purposes:

1. Win-Loss record
2. Head to head
3. Runs allowed
4. Run differential (max run differential is + or – 8 runs)
5. Coin flip

22. No amplified speakers allowed at the ballpark. ie. Walk up music/ warm up music.

23. In the event of a weather issue, every effort will be made to get all the games played. The tournament director has the right to shorten games and change all scheduling to accommodate. Refund policy is as follows: 75% refund if no games played (covers trophies and diamond dry.)

24. No pets allowed on property.
